Due to post-Camp Fire circumstances of displacement, lack of common access to the internet, and a need to act immediately, by agreement all Executive Committee members of Paradise Community Guilds were called individually by David Leon Zink, President, for the purpose of holding an Executive Committee meeting: Michael Walden and Karen Quattlander (11:08AM, in Indio), Jennifer Petersen(11:14AM, in Magalia), Dan Joseph (11:21AM, in Chico).

David moved to retain the law firm Baum Hedlund Aristei Goldman to represent our interests in a lawsuit against PG&E seeking damages incurred by Paradise Community Guilds in the scorching of our property and loss of our hall and all its contents (5704 Chapel Drive, Paradise, CA 95969) in the Camp Fire, Nov. 8, 2018.

The motion was seconded by Michael Walden.

Discussion: David explained that Baum Hedlund wanted to file the suit before PG&E filed for bankruptcy, which it could do any day. It is strategic to join the suit in the first filing. Michael voiced his opinion that holding PG&E accountable made sense in light of the need to change how power is generated and distributed in the current climate. Karen Quattlander noted that any compensation would likely occur well into the future due to the length of the legal process. Jennifer felt the compensation would be helpful to us, but agreed that adding pressure that may result in a change toward safe power delivery is the objective. Dan concurred.

After individual discussion David called the question in each conversation. The motion passed unanimously.

The meeting was adjourned at 11:30AM.
